10:00am- 10:05am Welcome & Call to Order Chair

- The Chair calls the meeting to order at 10:01am ET.
- Dan Logsdon, Kaitlyn Bison, and Imani Smith (CSG) present. Jay Phillips (EMWN Law) is substituting for interim counsel Samantha Nance.

10:10am – 10:15am Review and Adopt Agenda* Chair

- Angela Fileccia moves to adopt the agenda, Youa Yang seconds. Motion carries.

10:15am – 10:20am Review and Adopt Draft Meeting Minutes* Chair

- David Fye requests clarifications on spelling of Chair’s name on page one; and Page three (bottom) that licensee wouldn’t apply for a single-state license; fourth page (last bullet before delegate questions/comments), insert motion regarding length of time.
- David Fye moves to approve the minutes with requested amendments, Angela Fileccia seconds. Motion carries.

10:20am – 10:40am Discussion: Draft Rule on Transfer of Home State Chair/Interim Legal Counsel

- Substitute Interim Legal Counsel presents clarifying comments and redlining changes from legal counsel within the document.

- Section 1: The Chair requests a clearer definition included in Section 1 “Definitions” for “new home state”.
 - David Fye notes differences between “previous” and “prior” home states, suggests a narrower term. Justin Bennett agrees.
 - Substitute Interim Legal Counsel notes previous discussions on term in Section 7 of the compact legislation.
 - Bison notes “prior home state” found in compact legislation, suggests consistency and clarifying the definition. The Chair agrees.
- Section 3:
 - Justin Bennett makes motion to approve the drafting of language by legal counsel, Angela Fileccia seconds. Motion carries.
 - Angela Fileccia asks a question regarding states who do not have provisional license pathway.
 - David Fye notes the inclusion of the word “may” as optional towards provisional authorization. Bison will clarify with legal counsel.
 - The Chair clarifies this is more of a provision for the compact. Youa Yang agrees, notes revocation language to be denied.
 - Justin Bennett notes previous conversation that the onus of the day-limits for reporting is for the licensee.
 - Comments included in the document for follow-up by legal counsel.
 - Justin Bennett notes revocation regarding home state license, suggesting including a definition for the word. Comment is added to the draft.
- Section 4.3:
 - Section rewritten by legal counsel.
 - The Chair notes “denial” language here. Justin Bennett iterates that the new language may be redundant or potentially confusing, due to existence of provisional licensing measures in states. Suggests removing “provisional authorization” language.
 - Angela Fileccia says she agrees with Justin Bennett’s comments.
 - Youa Yang states that there may be circumstances where “provisional authorization” may apply but appreciates the language.
 - David Fye suggests adding “multistate” to make it compact-specific.
 - Substitute Interim Legal Counsel notes reference to subsection 2(Q) in compact language.
 - Justin Bennett denial of new home state license would cancel multistate license and is unnecessary to process between states. Notes definitions in sections 4 and 5. Recommends removing the rule’s section 3. Noted in the comments.
- Section 5.2:

- Interim Legal Counsel submitted question on potential situation if the new home state denies a single state license.
- Justin Bennett notes asking the state to record denial of license, and updating rule language to note the onus would be on recording that denial. Comment added to the draft.

- Section 6.1(A):
 - Angela Fileccia requests 30 business days here in place of 5 business days. The Chair asks about previous conversation on time limits regarding the 5 business days.
 - Bison suggests asking for timeline clarification from Compact Connect, depending on process the timeline could be more reasonable to keep 5 business days.
- Section 7:
 - Angela Fileccia notes 7.2 is potentially out of compact jurisdiction. Moves to remove section 7.2, David Fye seconds. Motion carries.
- Section 8:
 - Bison notes the clarifying comment from legal counsel.
- The Chair opens the floor for a motion regarding Section 3. Justin Bennett moves to remove section 3, Angela Fileccia seconds.
 - David Fye submits a friendly amendment to remove “PAP” definition from Section 1 as well.
 - Motion carries.
- Chair opens the floor for discussion on Section 6. Justin Bennett suggests consulting Compact Connect on the question, and verification language regarding data provided in the system.
 - Justin Bennett moves to strike section 6 and replacing with obligation of the new home state to verify data that they are issuing the license.
 - Youa Yang asks about circumstance if old home state does not timely deactivate the old license.
 - The Chair asks to table section 6, per asking Compact Connect about timelines.
